WHAT TO EXPECT



Admissions

The admissions office is here to help you from Monday to Friday, 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, and we're also available remotely during off-hours if you have any questions. Within your first few days with us, an admissions representative will come to meet you, walk you through the admissions paperwork, and collect copies of your insurance cards. We're here to make this process as smooth and easy as possible for you!



Physician Services

Each patient at our facility—whether you're here for short-term rehabilitation, a respite stay, long-term care, or hospice services—will be assigned to a dedicated physician group. Your assigned physician, along with their team of clinicians, will be responsible for your care throughout your stay. They will be available to address your daily medical needs and ensure that you receive the attention and support necessary for your well-being.



Medications

Medications will be provided by our contracted pharmacy. Upon admission, your hospital discharge medications will be ordered and sent directly to the facility. There is no need to provide your own medications as these are all included in your stay, unless otherwise instructed.





Social Services and Discharge Planning

Our social services department is committed to helping you find the resources you need, whether you're preparing to return home or seeking suitable placement options—be it with family, assisted or independent living, or long-term care within our facility. For those transitioning back to their homes, our social workers

will assist in arranging all necessary equipment, coordinating home care services, and setting up outpatient or home therapies. We aim to make your transition as smooth and comfortable as possible, ensuring that both you and your family are well-informed and supported throughout the process.



Therapy

The goal of our rehabilitation department is to help you regain your previous level of functioning—or even surpass it! We provide in-house Physical, Occupational, and Speech therapy, ensuring that each patient receives a personalized approach tailored to their specific exercise needs. Our therapy services are available seven

days a week, including holidays, to accommodate your schedule. Treatment plans are continually updated, and each patient will be scheduled based on their tolerance, insurance coverage, and individual requirements. We are dedicated to supporting you every step of the way on your path to recovery.



Long Term Care

We are contracted with most long term care policies for those who need 24 hour care and we accept private pay as well. Our business office will be happy to explain the process and guide you through the next steps when applying for Medicaid.

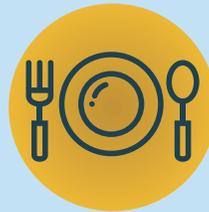

RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES



Our recreation department plans activities with patients in mind. From group events, entertainment, bingo, and independent activities, there's something fun for everyone to do 7 days a week! Activities calendars are posted throughout the building and given to each patient monthly.

DINING



Our dietary team provides quality and nutritious meals for breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Menu selection takes place every Tuesday for the week. Alternatives are available for every meal and snacks such as sandwiches, cookies, chips, etc., are available between meals.

CONCIERGE



Our facility has a concierge representative Monday to Friday from 10:30am to 6:00pm. The concierge is available to greet incoming patients as they arrive, review the admission process, answer any questions regarding your stay, and advocate for patient relations.



SALON SERVICES

Salon and Barber services are available once a week. Please see receptionist for salon schedule and to schedule your appointment.

LAUNDRY

Laundry services are available upon request for short term patients. Please have your items labeled and inform the concierge that you would like your laundry done in house.

MAINTENANCE

Maintenance is in the facility 7 days a week with emergency services available 24 hours a day, including holidays. Should you need maintenance for any reason, please inform a staff member.

ROAD MAP TO HOME

A 73-year-old female was admitted to **Atlas at Washington Township** following a series of complicated hospitalizations. After recently undergoing a cerebellar mass resection she was re-hospitalized due to a large intraventricular hemorrhage and hydrocephalus, necessitating the emergency placement of an external ventricular drain and a ventriculoperitoneal shunt. Her hospital stay was further complicated by **acute respiratory failure**, requiring the placement of a **tracheostomy** and a **PEG tube**. She was then transferred to **Select Willingboro LTACH** for complex medical management. In January 2024, she was transferred to us for subacute rehabilitation.

Upon initial assessment, patient's status was **dependent** with all facets of mobility and self-care. Patient was **non-verbal**, unable to express needs. Her PEG tube was still in place with a ground texture diet. Patient was treated by **Physical, Occupational, and Speech Therapy**. She had an incredibly supportive family that participated in many sessions providing unwavering encouragement.

She made steady progress throughout her SAR stay. **Communication improved** beginning with nonverbal gestures, progressing to single words then short sentences. At discharge in April, she completed self-feeding tasks on a **regular diet**. Her bed mobility improved to **supervision** and she could successfully ambulate **150 feet with a rolling walker** with supervision.

We are incredibly proud of this patient's remarkable progress and success. It has been a privilege to be part of her journey towards recovery. We are honored that she chose **Atlas at Washington Township** for her subacute care and rehabilitation.
